

# Scavenger Hunt

*Quilting isn't just a hobby—it's a way of life.*

## Pieced with Purpose

A mini scavenger hunt to reignite your momentum - spend 10-20 minutes, tricking your brain into having fun while getting stuff done!

- 3**  Wind 3 bobbins in neutral thread color  
 Change your thread and bobbin to actually match your current project!  
↓  
 Organize the supplies needed for one project  
 Sort scraps by color for 10 minutes  
 Match backing fabric to one top in your WIP pile  
 Replace your machine needle

- 5**  Join leftover binding strips into a “scrappy binding” roll  
 Test a new decorative stitch  
↓  
 Label a finished quilt (even a sticky note until you write it properly)  
 Grab your f-r-e-e label [templates here](#)  
 Pet your prettiest fabric and whisper, “Someday, I’ll actually cut you.”  
 Find the bobbin that rolled under your sewing table.

- 15**  Write down the name of each WIP you have (on the [WIPs tracker](#))  
 Pair one quilt top with batting and fold them together  
↓  
 Photograph one UFO and share with a friend, or on social with your intentions to work on it.  
 Toss or repurpose fabric scraps smaller than 2"  
 Organize thread spools (and bobbins) by color

- 20**  Pair an orphan block with new fabric to give it a future.  
 Take a “before” (messy) and “after” (clean-er/ish) picture of sewing space  
↓  
 Pull a few fabrics that coordinate with the Pieced with Purpose Book Cover  
 Organize your patterns, books, or project bags

- 50**  Bonus points - change your rotary blade!  
**100**  Bonus points - share your own scavenger hunt sheet on your socials
